Note: Competitors in U18 categories can start in senior categories, if they fulfill the 2. kyu requirement and have a confirmation from a sport doctor that they are eligible to start in a higher age category. (Not just a regular examination).

IJF Rules exception:

U13	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● No bear hug - SHIDO ● Cross-grip without immediate attack = SHIDO <p>First occasion = MATE, further = MATE + SHIDO for following techniques and situations:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ All kansetsu and jime waza (prohibited) ○ Throws using one or both knees (like drop seoi nage) ○ Ura nage, yoko otoshi, sukui nage, sumi gaeshi, kata guruma ○ Kubi nage without previous grip, or in case of connecting the hands ○ Sutemi-waza without control of uke
U15	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Kanetsu and jime waza allowed ● In case of effective kansetsu waza, the referee can declare “Technical ippon” without actual tap out from the uke. This is to prevent injuries. ● If a competitor falls asleep because of jime-waza technique, he or she is prohibited from further participation in the competition.
U18 + Seniors!	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● If a competitor falls asleep because of jime-waza technique, he or she is prohibited from further participation in the competition.

Competition systems:

- **2 competitors** - Best of three
- **3 to 6 competitors** - Pool (In case of three-way tie, lightest competitor is declared winner)
- **6 and more** - K.O. System with double repechage

Weigh-in: Weigh-in takes place in clubs itself, the data will be sent back to the organiser through the registration system. Further instructions will be specified.

Control weigh-in: Before the start of each category, random control weigh-in takes place. Randomly selected competitors are obliged to go through weigh.in. Allowed tolerance is +5 % of the category limit. In case the competitor fails random weigh-in, **he is not allowed to compete without money return.**

Approximate time schedule of the random weigh-in:

- 8.30 – U13
- 10.30 – U15
- 13.30 – U18
- 15.00 – Men / Woman

Approximate start times of the categories:

- 9.00 – U13
- 11.00 – U15
- 14.00 – U18
- 15.30 – Men / Woman

Prizes: Competitors at first 3 places obtain a medal and a diploma.

Protests: With 100 Kč deposit to the tournament director. In case of successful protest, money is returned.

COVID requirements: Necessary to have one of the following, with ability to prove so (no self certificates allowed):

- **Valid PCR (3 days)**
- **Antigen test (1 day)**
- **Ended vaccination (14 days since last dose)**

These rules apply for every participant, organiser, referee, coach, spectator or anyone in the hall with no exceptions!

BY REGISTERING TO THIS TOURNAMENT, THE PARTICIPANTS (COMPETITORS, COACHES, SPECTATORS AND ORGANIZERS) GIVE THEIR LEGAL CONSENT TO:

- processing and evidence of personal data by valid law n. 101/2000Sb for identification of the competitors and other participants during the competition. Czech Judo Federation and the organiser commit to process this data in order with valid law regulations (law n. 101/2000Sb about privacy policy) and use them only to the necessary extent for fulfilling the purpose that the data were collected for and always prevent any harm of the person, whose data are processed.

- processing and publishing photographs and video recordings, which capture participants during the tournament, in press or in other form of electronic media

BY REGISTERING, THE COMPETITORS ACKNOWLEDGE THAT:

- they participate at their own risk

- it is their obligation to be aware of their health condition and all security measurements of the competition, mainly with the fact that participation in the tournament can be physically difficult.

- they commit to respect all instructions from the organisers, or people entrusted by the organiser

- Czech Judo federation and the organiser are not obliged to compensate any harm on health or property for the participant, who did not follow these regulations

- All activities done during the competition, which by their means or good manners can not be considered a part of the competition, are considered personal issues. For such behavior, the organiser or Czech Judo Federation are not responsible

- everyone needs to comply with *Rules for organising tournaments during the COVID19 pandemic*, issued by Sport-Technical Commission of Czech Judo Federation on 1st September 2021, especially Necessary Precautions (respirators/masks every time and everyone except active phase of warm-up and during the contest, hand sanitization, 1,5 m spaces between people ...)

The competition will be running on 4 tatami, by valid Czech Judo Federation rules and these outlines.
